參書守則

參賽者遞交作品,即視作同意並接受下列參賽守則:

- 参賽者必須填妥參賽表格上的所有資料,並且在「參賽者聲明及承諾」一欄簽署作實;參賽者的家長或監護人必須在「參賽者聲明及承諾」一欄加簽。未有簽署/加簽或未能提供足夠資料者,可能會被取消參賽資格。
- 參賽作品不得標示參賽者的個人資料及學校名稱。參賽者亦須注意相關組別的字數(包括標點符號)要求,參賽作品的字數不得超過訂明範圍。
- 3. 除初小組外,其他組別的參賽作品須在參賽表格<u>註明書籍或閱讀資料</u> 的詳情及出處:
 - 書籍一書名、作者、出版社名稱及出版年份;
 - 報刊一報刊名稱、頁面編號及印發日期;
 - 網頁—網頁名稱、網址及瀏覽日期;以及
 - 非印刷品資料—出處及出版年份。
- 4. 各組別的參賽作品必須符合以下規格:
 - 初小組參賽作品須為A4尺寸(210毫米×297毫米),繪畫在單面白畫紙上。
 - 其他組別的參賽作品可用電腦打印(字體使用細明體,英文使用 <u>Times New Roman</u>,字型大小為<u>12</u>)或以黑色原子筆書寫在400 格的原稿紙(中文作品適用)或A4尺寸(210毫米×297毫米)的 單行紙(英文作品適用)上。如使用電腦打印,請保留作品的電子 原文檔。得獎者或須提供參賽作品未經修改的電子原文檔供主辦 機構作「參賽守則」第(9)項訂明的用途。未能提供電子原文檔的 參賽者,會被取消資格。
- 5. 參賽作品一經遞交,便不得修改,無論得獎與否,概不發還,並歸政府 所有,政府可予以銷毀。參賽者宜自留底稿,所有作品均不會退還。
- 6. 参賽者須將參賽作品保密,並採取所需措施確保在得獎名單公布前,不會向任何第三方透露作品內容,以及不會以任何形式或經任何渠道(包括但不限於網上)發表或出版該作品。參賽者如違反「參賽守則及規例」,將被取消參賽資格。
- 7. 参賽者須確保其參賽作品為個人原創,從未參加類似比賽。如主辦機構有合理理由認為(i)任何參賽者或參賽作品涉及抄襲、侵犯版權、

違反或抵觸任何香港法例;或(ii)任何參賽者曾經或正在作出可能導致或構成發生危害國家安全罪行或不利於國家安全的行為或活動,可取消參賽者的參賽資格及獎項(如有),參賽者須就其違規行為承擔法律責任。對於源於或涉及(a)參賽者遞交參賽作品;(b)政府、其獲授權使用者、受讓人及所有權繼承人使用、操作、保管或管有所遞交的參賽作品或其任何部分;或(c)參賽者違反「參賽守則及規例」而導致任何人因其知識產權或任何其他權利遭侵犯或指稱遭侵犯或與此相關的原因而向政府、其獲授權使用者、受讓人及所有權繼承人提出的一切申索、訴訟、法律程序、法律責任、損失、損害賠償、要求、收費、費用及開支,不論性質為何,每名參賽者均須對政府、其獲授權使用者、受讓人及所有權繼承人作出彌償,並使其持續得到十足和有效的彌償。

- 8. 主辦機構無須承擔任何因參賽者違反「參賽守則及規例」而引致的 法律責任,並有權取消任何違規參賽者的參賽資格。被取消資格者須 向主辦機構退還任何獲頒的獎項及獎品。
- 9. 每名得獎者保證其為得獎作品的唯一版權擁有人,並同意為惠及政府、其獲授權使用者、受讓人及所有權繼承人而授予他們一項無須繳付版權費用、非專用、不可撤銷、全球適用、可轉讓、可再轉授及永久的特許,以供他們以任何方法或方式使用(包括但不限於作出在《版權條例》(第528章)第22至29條下任何受版權所限制的作為)得獎作品內容作任何用途,包括但不限於以紙本及電子形式複製、編輯/剪輯、記錄、刊登、發放複製品作售賣用途、免費派發複製品、展覽、宣傳、推廣、演繹、廣播、傳播;以及貯存於政府管理或使用的任何媒體/系統/網絡作公眾閱覽用途。政府改編、翻譯或修改得獎作品而產生的所有知識產權,不論性質為何,均屬政府獨有和專有,一經產生,即歸政府擁有。
- 10. 評審結果以評判委員及主辦機構的決定為準。參賽者不得異議,並同意公開展示評判委員就其作品提出的意見。
- 11. 主辦機構對評審工作安排有最終決定權,並且有權不頒發任何獎項及 獎品,參賽者不得異議。
- 12. 主辦機構可全權更改參賽細則和參賽守則及規例,而無須獲得參賽 學校及參賽者同意。條款及條件如有任何更改,主辦機構會於其網頁 發布。參賽學校及參賽者不得異議。

- 14. 每名參賽者保證其所遞交的參賽作品為個人原創;政府、其獲授權使用者、受讓人及所有權繼承人使用、操作、保管或管有其所遞交的參賽作品或其任何部分既沒有亦不會侵犯任何人的任何知識產權或任何其他權利。
- 15. 每名參賽者現放棄其所遞交的參賽作品的所有精神權利(不論是過去、現在或將來的精神權利),而放棄上述權利屬不可撤銷。放棄權利須惠及政府、其獲授權使用者、受讓人及所有權繼承人,並須在向政府遞交參賽作品時生效。



Each winner will be awarded a book coupon of HK\$500, a medal and a certificate. A trophy will also be presented to the school of each winner.

Eligibility

- (1) Participants must be local full-time students (Primary 1 to Secondary 6).
- (2) All entries have to be nominated by schools.
- (3) Each school may nominate up to 5 entries for each category.

- For submission by email, the original application forms bearing signatures of the students, parents/ guardians, and school chops should be subsequently submitted by post or in person within five working days after the deadline (to serve as official documents authorising the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (the Government) to use the entries concerned).
- Please specify "4 · 23 World Book Day Creative Competition in 2024_Name of the Participating School" on the subject of the email.
- Please state the names of participants, number of entries and titles for each category in the email.
- All entries should be submitted in **MS WORD** or **PDF** format in A4 size (210 mm x 297 mm), using the font <u>Times New Roman</u> (or 細明體 for Chinese entries) with a font size of <u>12</u>. Please pay attention to Point (4) of the Rules.
- For entries forwarded by email, the date on the forwarded email will be regarded as the date of submission. Any late submissions sent or forwarded by email will not be accepted.

Rules

Upon submission of their entries, participants will be regarded as agreeing to and accepting the following rules:

- 1. Participants must provide all the information as required in the application form, and sign the "Participant's Declaration and Undertaking" for confirmation. The "Participant's Declaration and Undertaking" must be countersigned by the participant's parent or guardian. Failure to sign / countersign or to provide sufficient information may lead to disqualification.
- 2. Participants' personal particulars and names of schools <u>must not</u> be shown on the entries. Attention should also be paid to <u>the number of words (including punctuation marks)</u> required for each category. The number of words should not exceed the specified range.
- 3 Except for the **Junior Primary Category**, entries of other categories must be submitted with <u>details and sources of books or reading materials</u> specified in the application forms:
 - Books title of the book, author(s), publisher and year of publication;
 - Newspapers and periodicals name of the newspaper / periodical, page number and date of issue;
 - Webpage information name of the webpage, URL and date of access; and
 - Non-print materials source and year of publication.
- 4. Entries of all categories must be presented in accordance with the following specifications:
 - Entries of the Junior Primary Category must be drawn on one-sided A4-size (210 mm x 297 mm) white drawing paper.
 - Entries of other categories may be printed by computer printers (using the font <u>Times New Roman</u>, or <u>細明體</u> for Chinese, with a font size of <u>12</u>) or written with a <u>black ball pen</u> on 400-grid script paper (for Chinese entries) or on A4-size (210 mm x 297 mm) single-lined paper (for English entries). Participants should retain the softcopies of their entries which are printed by computer printers. Award winners may be requested to provide the unedited softcopy of the entries to the organiser for the purposes specified in Point (9) of the "Rules". Participants who fail to provide a softcopy will be disqualified.
- 5. All entries, upon submission, cannot be amended and, whether becoming winning entries or not, will not be returned, and will become the property of the Government and may be destroyed by the Government. Participants are advised to retain a copy of their entries, as all entries will not be returned.
- 6. Participants shall keep their entries confidential and adopt necessary measures to ensure that the contents of their entries will not be disclosed to any third party, and will not be released or published in any form or through any channel (including but not limited to online channels) prior to the announcement of results. Participants who breach the "Rules and Regulations of Competition" will be disqualified.
- 7. Participants shall ensure that the entries are their original works which have not been submitted to any similar competition. Participants may be disqualified and have their awards (if any) revoked if the organiser has reasonable grounds to believe that (i) any participants or entries involve plagiarism, infringement of copyright, breach or contravention of any laws of Hong Kong; or (ii) any participants has engaged or is engaging in acts or activities that are likely to cause or constitute the occurrence of offences endangering national security or which would otherwise be contrary to the interest of national security. Participants shall bear legal responsibility for their acts of breach. Each participant shall indemnify and keep the Government, its authorised users, assigns and successors-in-title fully and effectively indemnified against all claims, actions, proceedings, liabilities, losses, damages, demands, charges, costs and expenses of whatsoever nature arising from or in relation to any infringement or alleged infringement of any intellectual property rights or any other rights of any person arising from or in connection with (a) the submission of the entries by the participant, (b) the use, operation, custody or possession of the submitted entries or any part thereof by the Government, its authorised users, assigns and successors-in-title, or (c) any breach of the "Rules and Regulations of Competition".

- 8. The organiser shall not be liable for any breach of the "Rules and Regulations of Competition" by the participants, and has the right to disqualify any participant who breaches the "Rules and Regulations of Competition". Disqualified participants shall return any award and prize received to the organiser.
- 9. Each award winner warrants that he/she is the sole copyright owner of his/her winning entry, and agrees to grant a royalty-free, non-exclusive, irrevocable, worldwide, transferable, sub-licensable and perpetual licence in favour of the Government, its authorised users, assigns and successors-in-title to use (including but not limited to doing any of the acts restricted by copyright under sections 22 to 29 of the Copyright Ordinance (Cap. 528)) the contents of the winning entry by any means or in any manner, and for any purposes including but not limited to reproduction, editing/clipping, recording, publication, issuing copies for sale, distribution of copies free-of-charge, display, publicity, promotion, interpretation, broadcast and dissemination in paper or electronic format, as well as storage in any media/systems/networks managed or used by the Government for public access. All intellectual property rights of whatever nature in adaptations, translations or modifications made by the Government to the winning entries shall be the sole and exclusive property of the Government and shall be and remain vested in the Government immediately upon creation.
- 10. The decision of the adjudicators and the organiser on the adjudication results shall be final. Participants shall raise no objection and agrees that comments made by the adjudicators on their entries may be exhibited in public.
- 11. The organiser has the right to make final decision on the adjudication arrangements and the right not to present any award or prize. Participants shall raise no objection.
- 12. The organiser has the sole right to vary the Details and the Rules and Regulations of Competition without the consent of the participating schools and participants. Any variation of the terms and conditions will be posted on the organiser's webpage. Participating schools and participants shall have no right to raise any objection.
- 13. Participants shall do and execute any further things and documents (or procure that the same be done or executed) as may be required by the Government from time to time to give full effect to the provisions in the Details and the Rules and Regulations of Competition and provide all such documents and materials to the Government within 14 days of the date of the Government's written request or such longer period as may be agreed by the Government in writing.
- 14.
