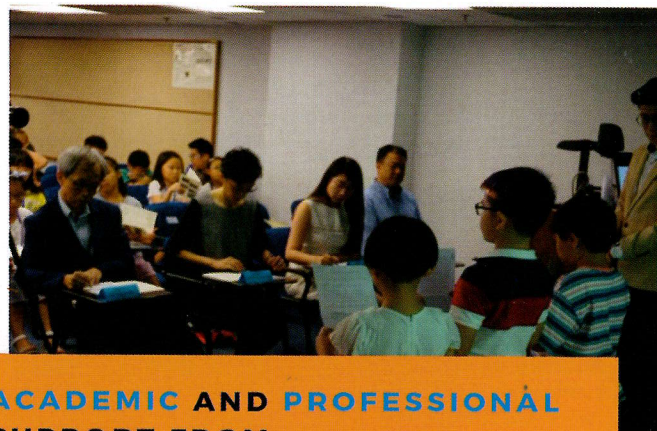
Hong Kong Primary Elite Scheme
