The activity inspired students to rewrite the beginning or ending of the stories. Please enjoy our student's work:







I have two sisters. I want to be a teacher when I grow up. I teach students in the classroom. I work in a primary school.





A Birthday Party



Dear Ms Blessing,


How are you? I am glad to receive your email.
