# Getting to know Mr Sean

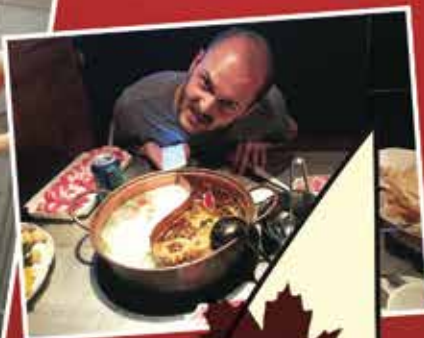
Mr Sean William Broadhurst

My Dream Job

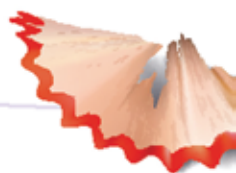
Do you want to be an engineer?
