Simon: Yes, I do a lot of exercise and eat healthy food, too.



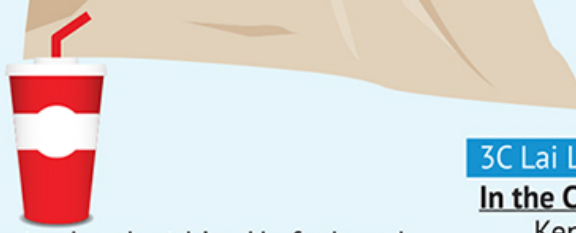
