'Museum as a Learning Space' is a **cross-disciplinary** opportunity for students to embark on a journey of creativity and level up their English abilities. Learn from experienced linguists and former museum experts, and dive into the world of curating. Participants will curate their very own exhibition—from **producing audio guides** and **editing interpretive texts and object labels**, to **presenting artworks in an exhibition setting**.

Using multimedia tools, students will conduct interviews with overseas artists and curators, join a virtual tour of the British Museum, visit the CUHK Art Museum in person, and curate their own exhibition in public spaces.

Scheme Schedule

Throughout the four-day intensive course, participants will work in groups to explore the main theme: **When Nature Speaks** by joining a series of learning activities led by our educators. Participants will curate a public exhibition as their final presentation. On the last day, professors, lecturers, experts, curators, and teachers will be invited to visit the exhibition and evaluate the students' performance.
